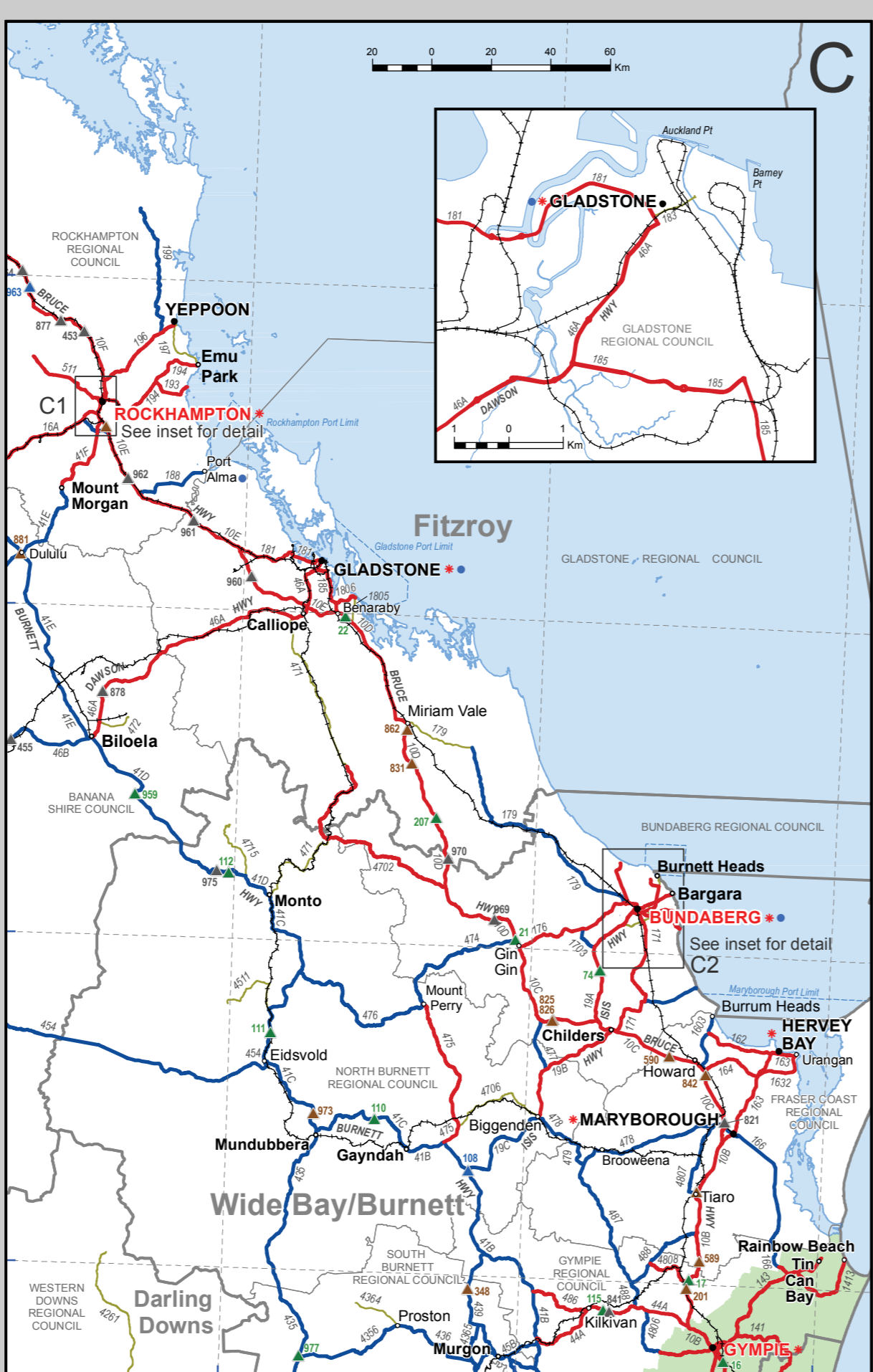
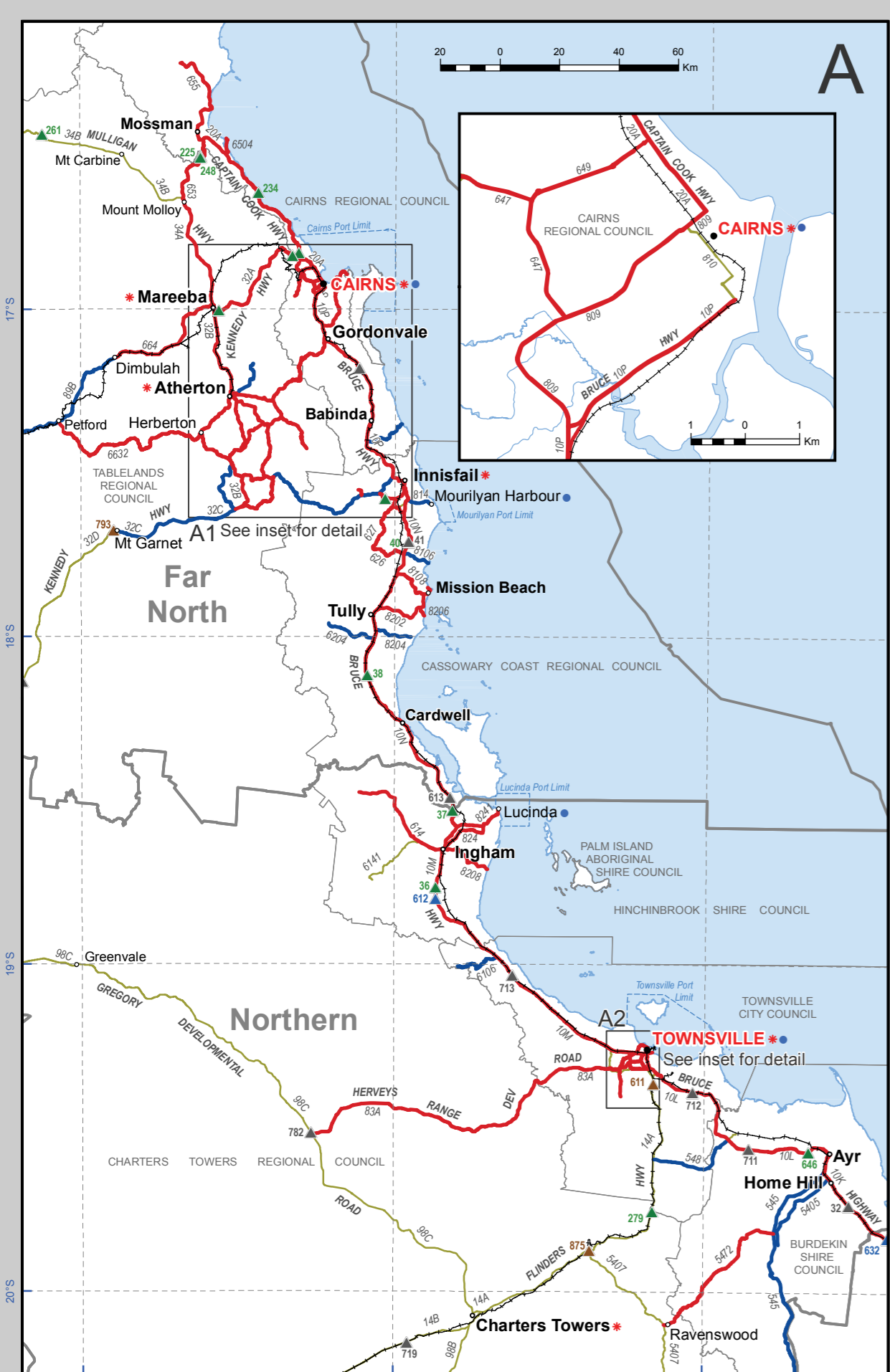

Critical Areas and roads in Queensland

This map has been produced to ensure there is adequate warning to motorists, of the movement of oversize vehicles and vehicle combinations accompanied by pilot and escort vehicles in critical areas and roads throughout Queensland.

The areas and roads have been determined by Department of Transport and Main Roads, the Queensland Police Service and industry representatives as requiring a greater number of escorts than are specified in the Guideline for Excess Dimension - Vehicles Carrying Indivisible Articles, Special Purpose Vehicles, Vehicles that require a Pilot or Escort Form Number 4 (Form 4)

Pilot and escort vehicle requirements when accompanying an oversize vehicle or vehicle combination exceeding 4.5 metres wide but not exceeding 5.5 metres wide are specified in the Guideline Form 4.

The following roads and areas have been specified on the map as requiring extra escorts:-

OPERATION ON STATE-CONTROLLED ROADS

- TYPE A (1 police, 2 escorts) - Red Line
- TYPE B (3 escorts) - Blue Line

OPERATION ON OTHER ROADS (By Area)

- TYPE A (1 police, 2 escorts) - Green Area
- Pilots and escort requirements of the Guideline Form 4 - White Area

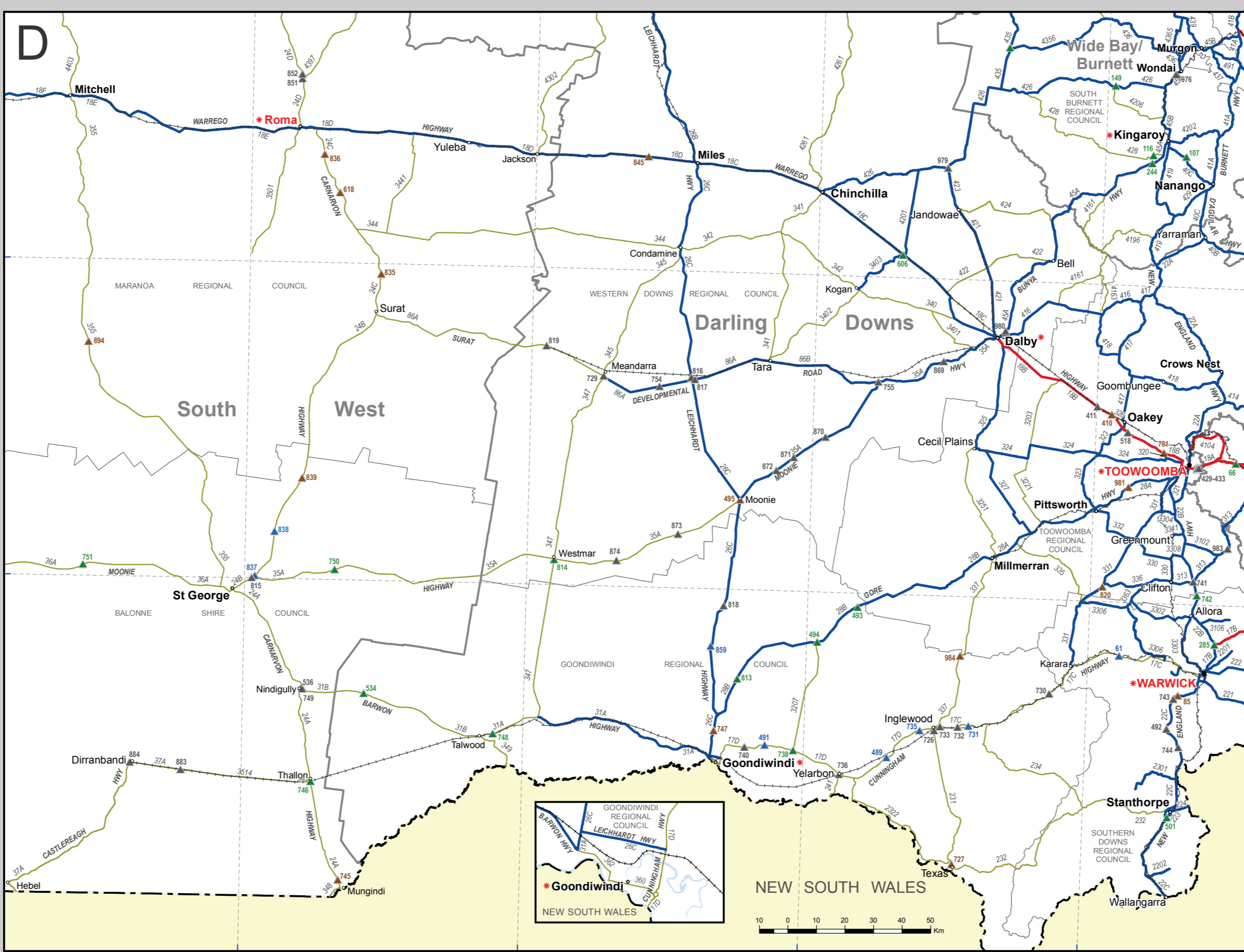
Pilot and escort vehicles required when accompanying oversize vehicles or vehicle combinations not exceeding 4.5 metres wide are specified in the Guideline Form 4.

Agricultural vehicles operating with or without their own motive power at a dimension which requires a pilot or escort vehicle are required to operate under the conditions of the Guideline for Excess Dimension Agricultural Vehicles and Agricultural Combinations Form Number 14.

Pilot and escort vehicle requirements when accompanying agricultural vehicles being transported on a vehicle or a trailer at a dimension which requires a pilot or escort vehicle are specified in the Guideline Form 4.

Operators of special purpose vehicles, as well as operators of vehicles transporting indivisible articles, at dimensions which require pilots or escorts are required to operate under the conditions of the Guideline Form 4.

For vehicles/combination in areas which require a greater number of escorts than specified in the Guidelines for Excess Dimension - Vehicles Carrying Indivisible Articles, Special Purpose Vehicles, Vehicles that require a Pilot or Escort - Form 4 and the Guideline for Excess Dimension Agricultural Vehicles and Agricultural Combinations - Form 14
