MURDER OF Abdul Basith MOHAMMED \$250,000 REWARD



REWARD: The Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Abdul Basith MOHAMMED at Kuraby on the 25th of October 2017.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

CIRCUMSTANCES: In the early hours of Wednesday the 25th of October 2017 Abdul Basith MOHAMMED exited his private house at Kuraby, to investigate the cause of a power outage. Within minutes of walking outside he was attacked and sustained multiple stab wounds to his abdomen and chest. Mr MOHAMMED died in the front yard of his home address.

Investigating police have initiated an Investigation Centre at Acacia Ridge Police Station to investigate the Homicide of Abdul Basith MOHAMMED.
