MURDER OF Julian John Neuendorf \$250,000 REWARD

REWARD: The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Julian John Neuendorf at Logan Reserve on 1 November 2012.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

CIRCUMSTANCES: At about 8:30pm on 1 November 2012 Julian John Neuendorf attended the Henderson Road Boat Ramp in Logan Reserve. At that location Neuendorf was shot and his body placed in the Logan River.
