## MURDER OF Tiahleigh PALMER

# \$250,000 REWARD



**REWARD:** The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Tiahleigh PALMER between the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2015 at Marsden and the 5<sup>th</sup> of November 2015 at Pimpama.

**INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION:** In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

**CIRCUMSTANCES:** On Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2015 Tiahleigh PALMER was last seen alive at Marsden. Her deceased body was subsequently located near the Pimpama River on Kerkin Road North, Pimpama at 5.37pm on the 5<sup>th</sup> of November 2015. Investigating Police have initiated an Investigation Centre at the Logan Police Station to investigate the suspected Homicide of Tiahleigh PALMER.
