MURDER OF Tiahleigh PALMER

\$250,000 REWARD



REWARD: The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Tiahleigh PALMER between the 30th of October 2015 at Marsden and the 5th of November 2015 at Pimpama.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>: On Friday the 30th of October 2015 Tiahleigh PALMER was last seen alive at Marsden. Her deceased body was subsequently located near the Pimpama River on Kerkin Road North, Pimpama at 5.37pm on the 5th of November 2015. Investigating Police have initiated an Investigation Centre at the Logan Police Station to investigate the suspected Homicide of Tiahleigh PALMER.
