## MURDER OF Donna Louise Steele

## \$250,000 REWARD



**REWARD**: The Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Donna Louise Steele between the 2<sup>nd</sup> of August 2017 and the 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2017 at Cooktown.

**INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION**: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Queensland Police Service.

**<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>**: On Wednesday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of August 2017, Donna Louise Steele was last seen alive at Cooktown. Her deceased body was subsequently located at Leggett's Crossing, a branch of the Endeavour River, Cooktown at 5.30 am on the 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2017. Investigating Police have initiated an Investigation Centre at Cooktown to investigate the suspected homicide of Donna Louise Steele.
