MURDER OF GARY JAMES VENAMORE

\$250,000 REWARD

REWARD: The Minister for Police and Corrective Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Gary James VENAMORE near Kinellan Point, New Farm on or about 6 November 1968.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

CIRCUMSTANCES: At 6.50am on 6 November 1968 Gary James VENAMORE, aged 35 years, met his death by violence. His body was recovered from the Brisbane River near Kinellan Point, New Farm.
