 At about 10pm on 28 December 2015 police officers in the Aurukun PLO vehicle were travelling on Kang Kang Rd, Aurukun, when the vehicle was attacked and struck numerous times with a machete.

- A number of street fights ensued between Aurukun families from the Top End and from the Bottom End along Kang Kang Rd.
- During this time houses occupied by Council Staff were targeted and as a result police and Council Security evacuated ten people to the police compound.
- Offenders have broken into the General Store and are believed to have stolen a large quantity of goods.
- Offenders have also stolen two vehicles from the Council Depot. One of those vehicles has been recovered – it is believed to have been used in an attempt to ram open the Post Office roller door. The other vehicle remains outstanding.
- The main issue for police was not being able to engage with the large crowd due to projectiles being thrown, which included spears and pieces of steel. The hours of darkness aggravated the situation.
- No police have been injured. It is unknown if any member of the community has suffered an injury.
- There was no hostility towards the police station and compound.
- On the morning of 29 December, 2015, police have deployed to the business precinct to secure the store and Council offices. If they locate any suspects they will attempt to take them into custody.
- Information from Inspector James is that alcohol did not play a significant part in the tensions.
- There is a need to arrest and identify the main offenders. It is considered that once these offenders are in custody, this will assist to alleviate the situation.

Proposed Response

MINISTERIAL BRIEFING NOTE / APPROVAL

SUBJECT: COMMUNITY UNREST AND THE DEATH OF A MALE PERSON IN AURUKUN.

PURPOSE:

 To provide information on the death of a male person in Aurukun and continuing community unrest.

BACKGROUND:

- 2. There is historical and continuing conflict between the Sch4p4 and Sch4p4(6) families in Aurukun. Tension has escalated in the community in recent weeks since the death (suicide) of Sch4p4(6) from the Sch4p4(6) family and information that one of the Sch4p4(6) family had purchased a shotgun. Since being made aware of the firearm, police have made investigations to locate the firearm with negative results to date
- 3. On the evening of Saturday 21 November 2015, a number of disturbances occurred throughout the community. The sequence of events is that several members of the Sch4p4(6) family were armed with the firearm and attended residences occupied by the Sch4p4 family. A number of shots were discharged during this time including one where pellets have struck a police vehicle. No community member or officer was hurt, however the police vehicle has received minor damage.
- 4. In retaliation to the discharging of the firearm, some members of the sch4p family, using vehicles, chased the Sch4p4(6) who were on foot. Sch4p4(6)

ISSUES:

- 5. At the time of the disturbance there were 10 police officers based in Aurukun.
- On Sunday 22 November 2015 additional police were deployed to Aurukun including the Inspector, Cape Patrol Group, detectives, Cairns Tactical Crime Squad (TCS), Scientific and Scenes of Crime, Forensic Crash Unit and Dog Squad.
- 7. An Incident Command Centre has been established in Cairns to support the deployment.
- 8. The investigation to date has identified suspects and offences.
- The driver of the vehicle has been identified and has been placed under arrest and is in custody. Another male person who fired the shotgun on Saturday night has also been arrested this morning and is in custody.
- 10. While the mood of the community settled overnight, tensions remain as the weapon remains outstanding. Police are continuing to negotiate the surrender of the weapon.
- 11. This morning, a number of residents have made their way to outside the police station due to concerns of conflict between the families. The group is not threatening police. There have also been a number of verbal disputes between the families. At this time police have not identified any threatening behaviour towards other government employees.
- 12. Liaison has continued with stakeholders in the community including the Mayor, CEO of the Council and government agencies. Council has opened today.
- 13. The situation remains dynamic and there are a number of trigger points occurring over the coming days which may inflame family tensions. These include the return of the body of the deceased Sch and the removal of the body of the male killed on Saturday evening.

Far North District advise the following:

- The community remains quiet with reduced calls for service not related to the previous conflict.
- Fifty offenders have been arrested on ninety-five charges. Twenty-four of these
 offenders were remanded in custody to appear in Cairns Magistrates Court on
 22/1/16. Far North District will monitor and prepare for the possibility of remanded
 prisoners being granted bail and returning to Aurukun Community.
- A total of seventeen QPS members remain in the community. They are
 providing enhances police service and presence specifically focussed on Alcohol
 Management Plan (AMP) enforcement including arriving aircraft baggage and
 motor vehicle search.
- Far North District will maintain a minimum strength of fourteen officers at Aurukun until end of February 2016 to assist with service delivery and increase AMP enforcement and community liaison.
- Two staff are being deployed to Weipa in the coming week to deter and detect liquor entering Aurukun from the point of sale. The Weipa Liquor Accord is functioning and will be engaged to encourage industry based solutions/contributions.
- Many of the local Stakeholders and Government employees will be returning to the community this week. Far North District continues to work with other Departments in efforts in addressing chronic alcoholism, mental health, employment, education and community capacity building challenges at Aurukun.



Overnight update on Aurukun last 24 hours

 Two groups of persons (one from the residents living in the "bottom section" of town and one from the "top section" of town) came together at the town shop on Monday 21 December 2015. After exchanging some verbal insults they engaged in a number of consensual fair fights over a period of time.

- Those involved in the altercation were primarily women. Both sides
 occasionally rushed each other on mass and some were armed with
 varying weapons. There were no reported injuries and no complaints made
 to police.
- Arrangements have been made to minimise future contact between the two groups. In conjunction with the manager of the shop, one group will be permitted to shop in the morning and the other to shop in the afternoon.
- None of the aggravation was directed towards police.
- There were a couple of minor calls for service in Aurukun overnight. Nil related to the current unrest.
- A small number of people were affected by alcohol.
- AMP enforcement continues.
- Briefings will remain by exception only.
