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Item SH3: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.097 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

Item SH4: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.980 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

All of items SH1 to SH4 inclusive were contained within a small plastic tray labelled "SPRING HILL".

Item M1: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.994 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

Item M2: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.978 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

Item M3: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.989 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.


Item M4: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.862 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

Item M5: One amber glass ampoule of approximately 1 millilitre in volume, bearing manufacturer's labelling "...DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP 10mg in 1mL...", which contained 0.992 grams of a clear colourless mobile liquid.

All of items M1 to M5 inclusive were contained within a small plastic tray labelled "MITCHELTON".

6. The abovementioned items were submitted in relation to Gavin Trembath (complainant).
7. I understand that the ampoules in each of items SH1 to SH4 inclusive and M1 to M5 inclusive are to be examined for signs of tampering. I also understand that the ampoules are to be screened for the presence of morphine, and where possible, the amount of morphine present be determined.
8. Laboratory examinations and chemical testing were conducted on the abovementioned items. The results of the analysis are outlined below:
 - 8.1 The ampoules in each of items SH1 to SH4 inclusive and M1 to M5 inclusive were microscopically examined and compared with a control ampoule of DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE.
 - The open ampoule in item SH1 revealed the presence of a white translucent resin material adhering to the edges of the ampoule where it had been cracked open.
 - The open ampoule in item SH2 and all of the "intact" ampoules (items SH3, SH4 and items M1 to M5 inclusive) revealed visible signs of tampering when compared to a control sample of DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE. The examinations revealed that the open ampoule in item SH2 and all of the "intact" ampoules have been previously cracked open then physically fitted together and resealed with a white translucent resin. The white translucent resin observed on each items SH3, SH4 and items M1 to M5 inclusive was visually similar in appearance to one another as well as to the material observed on items SH1.
 - 8.2 The white translucent resin observed on each of items SH1 to SH4 inclusive and M1 to M5 inclusive was analysed using the technique of Fourier Transform Infrared Microscopy. This testing revealed that the white translucent resin observed on each of items SH1 to SH4 inclusive and M1 to M5 inclusive was consistent with epoxy resin. According to literature available in this laboratory, epoxy resin can be used as an adhesive for wood, metal, glass, stone and some plastics.

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- 8.3 The liquids in each of items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive were pH tested using Universal Indicator strips. The pH of the liquids in each of these liquids was found to be 6-7, which is neutral.
- 8.4 Literature available in this laboratory indicated that DBL™ MORPHINE SULFATE Injection BP ampoules are said to contain saline solution (a 0.9 % (W/V) solution of sodium chloride salt (table salt) in water). Presumptive chloride ion testing of the liquids in each items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive failed to reveal the presence of any significant levels of chloride in any of these items. This finding indicates to me that the liquids in each of items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive do not contain saline solution. Further testing of the liquids in each of these items using the technique of Fourier Transform Infrared Spectroscopy (FTIR) revealed them all to contain water.
- 8.5 The empty vials in each of items SH1 and SH2 and the liquids in each of items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive were screened for the presence of morphine using Gas Chromatography with Mass Spectrometric Detection (GC-MS). The results of this testing are as follows:
- Morphine was detected in the empty vial in item SH1 and the colourless liquids in each of items SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive.
 - No morphine was detected in either of items SH2 (empty vial) or SH3 (colourless liquid).
- 8.6 The liquids in each of items SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive were analysed to determine the amount of morphine base present in each of these items. The amount of morphine base found in each of items SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive is tabulated below:

- 8.7 According to the labelling on the ampoules submitted for testing, the quantity of morphine sulphate that should be present in the liquids in each of items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive is 10 milligrams (which is equivalent to 3.760 milligrams of morphine base). As can be seen from the results outlined in each of paragraphs 8.5 and 8.6 above, there is no detectable morphine in the liquid in item SH3 and the level of morphine base in each of items SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive, is well below that which is stated to be present in each of the ampoules.
9. I am of the opinion that all of the ampoules submitted for analysis (items SH1 to SH4 inclusive and M1 to M5 inclusive) show evidence of tampering.
10. I am of the opinion that the morphine/saline solution that was once contained within the ampoules in each of items SH3, SH4 and M1 to M5 inclusive has been removed and replaced with water, following which, the ampoules have then been resealed using epoxy resin.
