

3. TEN ROUND DETACHABLE MAGAZINES FOR CATEGORY B RIFLES

Under the provisions of new section 68CA (effective 2 April 2012) of the *Weapons Regulation 1996*, registered owners of Category B lever or pump action rifles, must not possess a **detachable** magazine with a capacity of more than 10 rounds.

Registered owners of a Category B rifle (other than lever/pump action) must not possess a detachable magazine with a capacity of more than 15 rounds. It is permissible to have a bolt action Category B rifle with a 15 round detachable magazine.

This restriction does not apply to integral (tube) magazines in lever action or pump action rifles. It does apply to detachable magazines on rifles such as the Remington 7600 series of rifles which, as a pump action rifle, is limited to a 10 round detachable magazine.
