**Guidelines for the Necessary Attachments to the
Application by a Government Entity for an Area of Public Land
to be Prescribed as Motorbike Control Land**

In support of the application the following attachments form part of and should be attached to, the application:

1. The results of consultation under section 10(1)(a),
(A full report on this matter can be attached as an annexure.),
namely the consultation undertaken with
 - the district officer of the police district for the area; and
 - the local government for the area; and
 - a person, or a representative of a person, who is living in or adjacent to, or carrying on business in or adjacent to the area.
2. A copy of the newspaper notice as required by section 10(1)(b) and section 10(2).
3. Details of the newspaper the notice was published in.
4. Details of all of the other reasonably necessary steps that ensured persons who may reasonably be expected to be affected by the proposal are notified.
 - Include, as attachments, copies of all notifications made and copies of all written submissions received.
5. Details of any other consultation conducted, and the nature and results of the consultation.
