MURDER OF Tina GREER



\$250,000 REWARD

REWARD: The Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the suspected murder of Tina Greer on or about 18 January 2012 at Clumber. The reward is also offered for information which leads to the discovery of Tina Greer's remains or the apprehension and conviction of any person(s) acting as an accessory after the fact to the suspected murder of Tina Greer.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

CIRCUMSTANCES: Tina Louise Greer, date of birth 26 January 1979, was last seen departing Tamborine on 18 January 2012 to travel to an address in Clumber. Investigating Police have initiated an Investigation Centre at the Ipswich Police Station to investigate the suspected Homicide of Tina Louise Greer.
