MISSING PERSON STEVEN JAMES GOLDSMITH

\$250,000 REWARD

REWARD: The Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearance of Steven James GOLDSMITH, 28 years, last seen at New Farm on 10 July 2000.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In the case of an offence being identified, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250 000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>: Steven James GOLDSMITH was reported missing in the Fortitude Valley Division on 28 July 2000. The last confirmed sighting of the missing person was Monday 10 July 2000 at New Farm.

The missing person was captured on CCTV conducting an ATM transaction at the Commonwealth Bank New Farm and was reported missing by friends when he could not be located for work as an Arborist.

All inquiries to date have failed to locate GOLDSMITH or determine the exact circumstances behind his disappearance. Investigating Police consider that GOLDSMITH may have met with foul play.
