## Suspicious death of Jason Barry Guise

## \$250,000 REWARD



**REWARD**: The Minister for Police and Minister for Corrective Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the suspicious death of Jason Barry GUISE on or about 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2019 at Wynnum, Brisbane.

**INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION**: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Queensland Police Service.

<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>: On the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2019, Jason Barry GUISE (18/10/1973) was reported missing. On the 8<sup>th</sup> of May 2019, the body of a male was located in a pit within a sewage treatment plant at Wynnum. This body was identified as Jason GUISE. The last known confirmed sighting of Jason GUISE was when he was depicted riding a bicycle past the Waterloo Hotel on Berrima Street Wynnum at about 7:16pm on the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2019. Evidence obtained supports that Jason GUISE died shortly thereafter. Investigating Police have initiated an investigation centre at the Bayside Criminal Investigation Branch to investigate this suspicious death.
