MURDER OF Omega Ruston

\$250,000 REWARD



REWARD: The Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 to be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Omega Ruston on 26 January 2009 at Burleigh Heads.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

CIRCUMSTANCES: The Queensland Police Service is investigating the murder of Omega Ruston who died as a result of a gunshot wound on 26 January 2009. Police believe he was shot at Gold Coast Highway Burleigh Heads by person/s unknown to him. Investigating detectives are appealing for public assistance for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of any person/s responsible for the murder of Omega Ruston.
