## MURDER Of Shane Bowden \$250,000 Reward



**REWARD**: The Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of \$250,000 be offered for information which leads to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Shane Bowden on 12 October 2020 at Pimpama.

**INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION**: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$250,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Police Service.

<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>: The Queensland Police Service is investigating the homicide of Shane Bowden who was murdered in the garage of his residence at Cox Road, Pimpama on 12 October 2020. Investigating detectives are appealing for public assistance for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person responsible for the homicide of Shane Bowden.
