RAJWINDER SINGH (Buttar Kalan, India)

REWARD AU\$1,000,000 (Approx. INR 5,10,00,000)

REWARD: The Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services has approved a reward of up to \$1,000,000 for information leading to the location and arrest of Rajwinder Singh (d.o.b. 15/07/84) originally from Buttar Kalan, India. Previously a resident of Innisfail North Queensland, Australia.

INDEMNITY FROM PROSECUTION: In addition, an appropriate indemnity from prosecution will be recommended for any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

The allocation of the \$1,000,000 reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of the Queensland Police Service. Please note that all Law Enforcement Officers are ineligible to be considered for the allocation of the reward.

CIRCUMSTANCES: On 21 October 2018 Toyah Cordingley was walking on Wangetti Beach north of Cairns, Queensland when she was brutally murdered. A person of interest in this matter has been identified as Rajwinder Singh from Innisfail, Queensland. Singh is originally from Buttar Kalan, Punjab India.

Queensland Police are appealing for public assistance for information leading to the location and arrest of Singh, who is believed to be in India.
