2. Data includes persons who has a person classification in QPRIME as police officer.
3. Domestic violence charge is considered to be any charge under the *Domestic and Family Violence Protection Act 2012* or charges with the domestic violence ancillary wording. Charges from the *Domestic and Family Violence Protection Act 2012* can include Contravention of domestic violence order (section 177) or contravention of police protection notice (section 178). Charges with the domestic violence ancillary wording refer to charges with the wording 'the offence is also a domestic violence offence' for offences other than against D&FVPA.
4. Charges preferred refers to the number of charges preferred against an offender. A person with multiple charges is counted multiple times.
5. Persons charged is a unique person count. A person with multiple charges is counted once per break down.
