The phot shows the positioning of this tree compared to the Police sign. It was QBuild's opinion that this was the cause of the sewer blockage rather than our Police sign footing. Hi Linda,

After discussing this further with QBuild I can provide the following summary of events. It is almost identical to the information provided by OIC Toni Poli in the body of this email. In short, we do not believe The QPS is responsible for any damage sustained to the neighbouring property.

- On the 8th of June 2020 OIC of Tannum Sands Police Stn -Toni Poli advised QBuild that the Gladstone Regional Council had isolated sewer lines to the Station without advice or approval

- It was later determined the GRC was investigating a sewer pipe blockage and thought the Police sign footing was the cause.
- QBuild CQ District Manager Sch4p4(6) provided advice to PSBA Property & Facilities on the matter and GRC's work.
- The GRC removed the Police sign and lay it beside the public footpath.
- The GRC suggested QPS/PSBA would be invoiced for their work.
- A QBuild Supervisor attended site 8-6-20 to investigate the Council's work and barricaded around the Police sign post to prevent injury to members of the public.
- The QBuild Supervisor advised the Police sign footing was not the cause of the blockage but rather tree roots from the trees located in the QCWA property.
- The Gladstone Regional Council arranged the sewerage line rectification works and completed all works on the 16th of June 2020.
- QBuild provided a quote to reinstate the Police sign in an alternate position. This was approved by PSBA and the work was arranged via QBuild.

Good Morning Inspector

We have received the attached letter from Moray and Agnew Lawyers on behalf of QBE insurance regarding sewerage damage to the QCWA hall. This hall is next to Tannum Sands Police Station and in 2020 had substantial damage caused through a sewer line blockage, with the law firm seeking \$170000 in compensation for damage and repairs.

The background and attachments are summarised:

- In June 2020 the Gladstone Regional Council inspected the site (see attached email with their reports and photos), suspecting the Police Sign at the front of the station may have caused damage and blockage to the sewer lines.
- They removed the sign and consultation commenced with QBuild. See below emails and attached photos.
- The result of the removal, investigation is mentioned below, with the sign footings not impeding on the sewer lines whatsoever. The photographs attached titled "timephoto..." explain this in a snapshot.
- The investigation shows, photos with notations on them explain this, that tree roots were the cause of the blockage.
- These tree roots come from trees on the QCWA property.
- The sign was left on its side, with the QPS having to pay for reinstallation through Connor Enterprises.
- I have further attached two photos titled QCWA tree removed 1 and 2. These show where trees have been removed from their property.

The letter from the law firm requests a response. If anything, the insurance company should be paying the re- instalment costs of the sign. The attachments and investigation by Council and Qbuild indicate the QPS is not liable whatsoever.

I send this for referral to the QPS solicitors office for appropriate reply.
