Remarks: Narrative:

At approximately 08:00am on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022 a Non Suspicious vehicle Fire occurred on the Bruce Highway Kybong, approximately 1 km kilometre North of Coles Creek Road.

Vehicle was a 2010 pink and maroon make; Quality Bus and Coach Standard, bearing Queensland Registration 02WNC. The coach was a 66 passenger seater.

The vehicle was being driven by Sch4p4(6) with Queensland drivers licence Sch4p4

The vehicle departed Chevallum and was travelling north in the left-hand lane towards Gympie when passengers observed/smelt smoke coming from the rear of the vehicle. Driver has then stopped the bus and ensured all 28 persons on the bus (including driver) alighted the vehicle to a place of safety off the side of the road. Driver conducted a count to ensure that all persons were accounted for.

Witnesses have contact '000' and notified emergency services of the incident. Police attended scene and observed the coach entirely engulfed in flames with black smoke bellowing from the whole vehicle. Police further observed multiple explosions coming from the vehicle. Police immediately removed passengers to a safer location away from the bus. Police then updated comms requesting QFRS and QAS who already been notified.

QFRS and QAS then attended the scene and extinguished the flames coming from the vehicle, this took a few hours to completely contain/extinguish.

QAS tendered to passengers and transported Sch4p4(6) to Gympie Hospital for medical aid in relation to Heat Stress due to Environmental conditions (not Fire from vehicle).

Vehicle fire caused considerable damage to the Highway resulting the road beneath the coach being turned to molten.

Claytons Towing attended the scene and removed the vehicle from the road and also conducted a site clean utilising a bobcat and skip bin for clean-up.

Queensland Transport and mains road (TMR) were notified and an inspector from TMR attended and inspected damaged and arranged for TMR to do maintenance to the road to fix damaged caused by the fire.

Police photographed the damage to the vehicle and uploaded these images to Evidence.com under related occurrence number. Police spoke the senior QFRS representative who indicated that the fire possibly commenced as per reported at the rear of the vehicle as this is where the engine is located at the back underneath the bus.

Responding police investigations indicate that the fire was in non-suspicious in nature and reported for insurance purposes.

police spoke with Sch4p4(6) Wests National Coaches who stated that the vehilce was fully insured through 'Sura" insurance company. Sch4p4(6)
