Sch4p4(6) has then walked into the rear yard of number Sch4p4(6) Riveredge Court and seen the rear wooded patio a blaze with fire. Sch4p4(6) has called out to Sch4p4(6) a Sch4p4(6)

Sch4p4(6) who immediately ran over to number Sch4p4(6) and used their garden hose of this residence to extinguish the fire which took about 5-minutes. The Tewantin QLD Fire Service has attended the scene shortly afterwards but the fire had already been extinguished by Sch4p4(6). There was a small amount of damage to the wooden timber floor and the small wooden table and wicker chair were destroyed by this small fire. Sch4p4(6) were contacted and informed of this fire and damage to the rear patio area. Sch4p4(6) Nil suspicious circumstances. No further Police investigation was required. SOC not required.
