Hi Cameron and Lorenzo,

We have tested the Securetec Drugwipe 3S kits with cocaine, and they produced positive results down to 25 ng/mL (75, 50 and 25 ng/mL tested). We also tested them with various levels of THC, MA and MDMA, with results comparable to the current kits, although they may be a bit better for MA.
