

The "declared locality" boundary has been moved slightly in some areas to improve cartographic display. Where the boundary is drawn along the outer edge of a road or watercourse, then the boundary is to be interpreted as being the centre of that feature. Where the boundary is outside of, and within three millimeters of, a watercourse, suburb border or railway line, then it is to be interpreted as being directly on that border or line.
