04/11/2010	CLARKS RD cnr MCKENNA RD RUBBISH DUMP RD BAKING BOARD QLD 4413	BAKING BOARD	<p>Unit 1 is a heavy vehicle. Unit 1 was towing one trailer containing a load of approximately 20 ton of dirt and rocks. Unit 1 was attempting to follow Clarks road around a left hand turn approximately 90 degrees. It appears Unit 1 was travelling too fast to safely make the turn and the truck left the road and rolled onto the drivers side. Both truck and trailer remained stationary on the drivers side off Clarks Road.</p> <p>Scene: Rural road 80km/h speed zone single lane. Sweeping left bend sealed road. SE direction.</p> <p>Time: Unknown exact time of crash, informant located at around 3:00pm. No other witnesses to crash. Vehicle still running at the time, oil leaking, water tank still leaking.</p> <p>Observations: Police attended and observed the involved vehicle on its side with cabin crushed. Sole occupant trapped in vehicle cabin driver's seat. Water leaking from 12,000L water tank - half full at time of crash. Oil leaking from vehicle. Vehicle fitted with baffles in the water tank.</p> <p>Observed vehicle tyre tracks leading from the start of the corner on the left side of the road and drifts to the right side in the middle of the corner before going over the edge and flipping.</p>
21/10/2020	CLARKS RD cnr CLARKS RD MCKENNA RD BAKING BOARD QLD 4413	BAKING BOARD	<p>At approximately 9pm U1 (police vehicle) driving West on Clarks Road, Chinchilla just past the intersection of Waterworks Road, when a large Kangaroo jumped out approximately 20 meters in front of U1 before quickly attempted to change direction in the middle of the road. U1 has immediately heavily engaged brakes, however vehicle was unable to come to a complete stop in time and consequently collided the front right of the vehicle with the Kangaroo.</p>
01/11/2020	CLARKS RD CHINCHILLA QLD 4413	CHINCHILLA	<p>Unit 1 was travelling west on Chinchilla Kogan Road when the vehicle has lost control after crossing a culvert on the road. The vehicle has overturned and hit a tree on the side of the road.</p> <p>A witness to this incident states that he observed a heavy vehicle travelling in the opposite direction drive through a large amount of water in the culvert that has splashed onto the front windscreen of Unit 1. The witness then observed Unit 1 immediately lose control following this and crash into a tree on the side of the road.</p>
16/03/2014	KOGAN CONDAMINE RD cnr KOGAN CONDAMINE RD R CLARKS RD KOGAN QLD 4406	KOGAN	<p>Police observed that the road was wet however on arrival observed no water laying on the road. No other debris or objects were observed that would have contributed to this accident.</p>
16/12/2014	KOGAN CONDAMINE RD cnr R CLARKS RD SIXTEEN MILE HALL RD MONTROSE QLD 4406	MONTROSE	<p>Police were called to attend a single vehicle traffic crash on the Kogan-Condamine Road at Montrose. At this location police observed an orange coloured mitsubishi truck that was towing a tandem trailer to have come to rest against a tree on the northern side of the roadway. The vehicle appeared to have been travelling in an easterly direction on Kogan-Condamine Road prior to the crash. There was extensive damage to the front driver's side of the vehicle. There was also substantial damage to the passenger side of the trailer due to colliding with other trees prior to the vehicle coming to rest.</p> <p>An inspection of the scene revealed that the vehicle had appeared to have travelled from its marked lane onto the incorrect side of the road before entering a roadway that had water at its extremities. Tyre marks at this location indicated that the offside tyres of the vehicle had left the bitumen roadway and had immediately started to sink in the mud. It would appear that this is what has caused the vehicle to pull dramatically to the left leaving the roadway and colliding with the tree. Nil evidence was located on the roadway (Tyre or skidmarks marks, gouges etc) that would indicate any defect or damage of the vehicle causing the crash.</p>
