

It's illegal to sell a knife to anyone under 18

Under the new law:

- It will be an offence to sell knives and particular controlled items to minors.
- It will be an offence to use false ID to purchase these items.
- It will be an offence to advertise these items as 'suitable for combat'.
- Retailers will be required to securely store particular controlled items prior to sale.
- Retailers will be required to display signage regarding age restrictions for sales.

Your responsibilities:

- ✓ Signage indicating that the sale of knives to individuals under 18 is illegal.
- ✓ Secure storage to prevent unauthorised access to items classified under the new law.
- ✓ ID checks to verify age before selling prohibited items. If they look under 25, ask for ID. Be alert for false IDs.
